Departments' "Guidance Notes" EXH12) in whose Stud Book the pony is listed. The Valuer or Judge must be selected from a list obtainable from the address given above;

- a Declaration from an officer of an international competition organisation (EXH 5) stating that the pony is being exported to take part in, or having taken official part in, an international competition.
